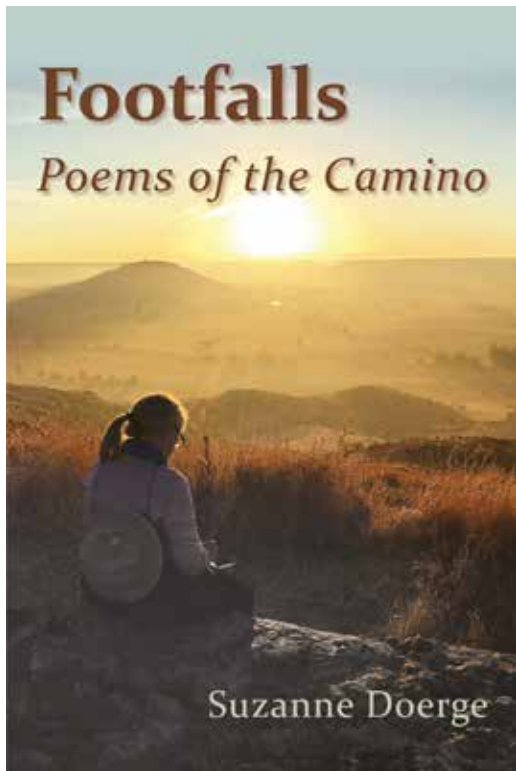


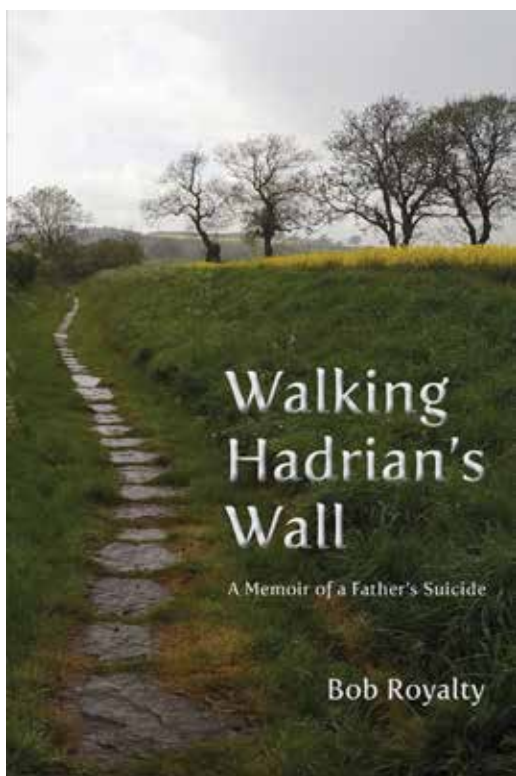

Walking as Meaning Making



Poet **Suzanne Doerge** will discuss and read from her book, ***Footfalls: Poems of the Camino***, which follows the seven-hundred-kilometer path in northwest Spain, part of the **Camino de Santiago** (also known as the **Way of St. James**), that the author walked in 2016. Each poem is a footfall of experience or insight lived on the Camino. The variety of contemplative, spiritual, humorous, political, and narrative poetry mirrors the shifts between wonder, delight, and effort lived on the Camino.



In 2016 author and historian **Bob Royalty** walked the Roman ruins of **Hadrian's Wall**, across northern England from the North Sea to the Irish Sea. A dream long in the making, his story is presented in ***Walking Hadrian's Wall***. As the account of the walk unfolds, testing himself against the physical strain of the 100-mile adventure, Royalty reflects upon his past personal experiences, including the suicide of his father, through the lenses of English and Roman history as well as religious and Biblical studies.
